

ACCOUNTABILITY COMMITTEE -MEETING MINUTES

**Reports:**

Student Leadership - Will be holding a Valentine's Day Sale of goodies for your sweetheart. STUCO will also be organizing dress up days during the week of Valentine's Day. A Spring Fling dance is being planned for March 11th.

**Action and Discussion:**

Oversight of SB 191 – 1338 Council - Teacher evaluations have been completed for the mid-year cycle. All formal evaluations have been completed for veteran teachers and nearly all new teachers. Evaluations have gone well.

Preschool Oversight - Universal Pre-School registration is now open on the state system. Our class sizes will be 20 students per session. Thus far, it looks like the revenue will be comparable if not more than last year.

Healthy School Index - Elbert School will not be participating this year.

Unified Improvement Plan - Submitted in October.

School Climate Survey - The Accountability committee reviewed the survey questions for staff, students and parents. The group agreed that the questions used last year were worth repeating this year. The group suggested an additional question be formulated to gauge parent input on which fees parents felt should be raised to compensate for the increasing cost of referees. Mr. Graves will work on the language for this question. Survey completion will be promoted at parent/teacher conferences. The surveys will likely be pushed out on February 28th.

Financial Recommendation - First School Board Work Session for budget will be February 15th at 6:30pm.
