- Be sure to use the most up-to-date version of your browser.

 - Mac: Safari (latest version), Google Chrome (latest version), Firefox (latest version)
 - We do not recommend using a mobile device to complete the course and form.
- Ensure your browser settings are enabled to allow the course to work.
 - When using Internet Explorer, turn off <u>Compatibility View</u>.
 - JavaScript must be enabled for published courses to work.
- Clear the browser cache to ensure that your device has the latest course content and it isn't accessing outdated or invalid files.
